BONE FRACTURE FACTS. Bone fracture healing results in regeneration of bone at the fracture site resulting in bone tissue that has similar biomechanical competence as before the injury. Fractures, or broken bones, are extremely common.

How Do Bones Heal? Hematoma. As soon as a bone breaks, a hematoma (blood clot) forms around the broken bones. **Callus.** After about a week, a type of bone called a callus starts to form. **New Bone Forms.** New bone starts to form in the weeks after the break. **Continued Healing.** Healed Bone.
